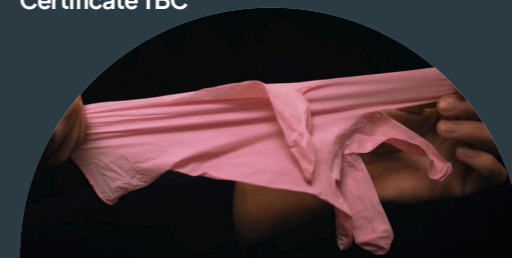


### Film Launch: **Milk Report 2025**
