






Please note:

Our building has lots of stairs, so do take the lift if it's easier - use floor 2 for the Round and floor 3 for the McCarthy (if you arrive early and your floor is unavailable, you can wait in our downstairs foyer or in the bar area on floor 1).

Access to most seats involves either climbing or descending stairs - we've marked handrails on stairs in red. In the Round, level access to the front row via the stage is often available on request.

At the end of January 2026 we'll be renumbering the seats in The Round, as shown on the plan above. 


